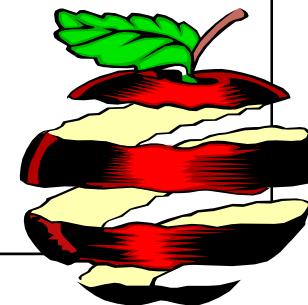

## Rules for Submission

### Poetry Category

**Single poems** up to 40 lines; **Collections** of between 6-10 poems - no restriction on length of poems in a collection. **Single poem** entries must be previously unpublished; previously published poems **can** be included as part of a **Collection**.  
 Entry fees: £5 for up to 2 single poems (TNW subscribers 4 poems for £5).  
 £12 per collection (no concessions).

### Fiction Category

**Short stories** up to 4,000 words; **Serials/Novellas** up to 20,000 words on any subject or theme, in any genre (**not children's**). Previously published material is **not** eligible for entry. Entry fees: £5 per short story (TNW subscribers 2 for £5).  
 £15 per Serial/Novella (no concessions).

### Non-Fiction Category

**Essays, articles and interviews** covering any writing-related or literary theme in its widest sense up to 2,000 words. Previously published material is not eligible.  
 Entry fees: £5 per entry (current TNW subscribers 2 for £5).

Open to all. Entries should be clearly typed, double-spaced (poetry should be single spaced) on white A4 paper and paperclipped or unbound. Entrants may make as many submissions as they wish and should include name, address, title of entry, word count and category on a separate cover sheet with every entry. Preliminary judging will be carried out by the editorial board with guest judges making the final selection so no identifying marks - apart from the title - on the entries. The judges' decision is final. Entries are non-returnable.

Runners-up will be published in The New Writer magazine throughout the year and paid accordingly.

A full list of winners will automatically be sent provided an SAE is enclosed with the entry(s). ALL ENTRY FEES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO **THE NEW WRITER** and sent to PO Box 60, Cranbrook, TN17 2ZR, UK.

If acknowledgement is required, enclose stamped addressed postcard.
